Use our Kroger Gift Cards to pay down our building loan

We have preloaded Kroger fundraising gift card available for \$5.00. Cards are available in the church office or on Sunday by seeing Letha Drury in the sound booth. You can use your card at all Kroger stores for groceries, gas and prescriptions. When cards are recharged at the store, MBC earns a 4% rebate from Kroger. Please don't throw away cards after the value is depleted, just keep continually recharging (or add value to) your card each time they go to Kroger. Gift Cards may be recharged in any amount up to \$500. Gift Services will have a check cut for 4% of ALL recharges over \$5000, which will be at least 200. IMPORTANT NOTE: It is important to keep activity on gift cards for organizations to earn their rebate. A gift card with a zero balance for 90 days will be voided out of the system. Kroger makes it very convenient for you to recharge their card. Gift cards may be recharged at ANY REGISTER and used immediately. If you recharge at the customer service desk you will have to wait up to five minutes for the funds to become available.

We are seeing lots of activity with our Kroger gift card program, we have received checks the past two months and need to keep growing this program. With your help we can continue to make additional monthly payments to the principle on our building loan.


Lord God, Creator of the universe, Loving Father,


