It is with much gratitude and appreciation that we say thank you for your decision to co-sponsor the Feza Norbert Family. Feza, her husband, Baruani and their 5 children will be blessed in their association with you all as church and as those who continue to welcome the stranger, as we are called to do.

Haley Wyatt and team have done an excellent job in preparing for the family's arrival on January 29th. It will, indeed, be exciting as they arrive in their new hometown and are taken to the apartment that you all have so generously furnished. If they knew they had a caring congregation to help them in these first few months how excited and grateful they would be!

MBC has agreed to support the family with three months of rent. The rent is \$855 per month. At this location, Fairway Apartments, utilities are not included in the rent. As we discussed, MBC will provide one check per month to KY Refugee Ministries for three months of rent. The checks will be mailed to the KRM at the end of February, March, and April, each for the following month's rent

Having to flee from persecution in one's homeland is a journey that most of us cannot imagine. Your support of this family as a church co-sponsor will make such a positive difference as they begin to build new lives for themselves in our community. You will provide much needed friendship, guidance, and advocacy in addition to the basic needs that any family as for a safe place to live. ## KRM Reflections From Ron Wyatt About Sunday, 01/31/16

This morning at MBC the message was delivered by the Reverend Kristin Belcher. She spoke on Corinthians 13, the Love chapter. While she was bringing the word, the Norbert family were seated on the front row. The Norberts are new to Kentucky. They spent last Tuesday night in a refugee camp in Tanzania after fleeing violence in the Congo.



Looking around the sanctuary, there

were people of all ages and descriptions. My daughter joined in the singing of the praise songs with great enthusiasm. I thought about all of my friends who were worshipping together. Quite a bit was happening in that space this morning. The Holy Spirit was present, I could feel it in my core.

So here in the south, in a Baptist church, a woman preached a sermon to the entire congregation. A diverse crowd listened and worshiped as one. An immigrant family experienced the love of God in a new land. Certainly a different experience than that of other immigrants, in other circumstances, in other times. No chains, no bondage, only love and hope.

Thank you to the Midway Baptist Church KY Refugee Mission Team for your leadership and hard work. I don't know what tomorrow will bring, but I know that each of you made the world a better place today. Thanks be to God for people like you and the people of Midway Baptist Church that are so giving and have great compassion for others.




#### SUNDAY SCHOOL MARCH MADNESS
