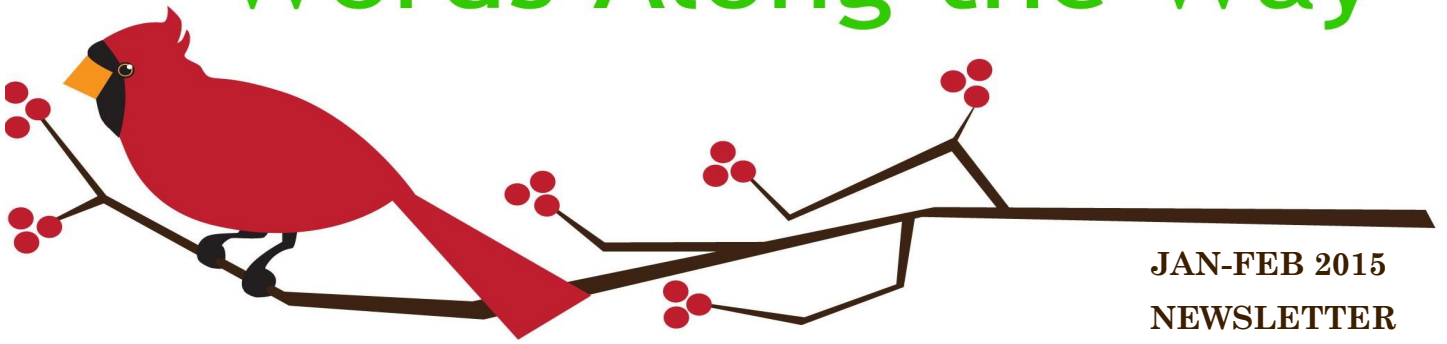

PRACTICING BALANCE: HARMONY IN LIFE, FAMILY, WORK AND FAITH GROUP

Wednesday Nights at 6:45 p.m. (Starting January 7, 2015)

Based on a recent national survey:

76% of mothers and 58% of fathers said they have “too little time for oneself”.

73% of mothers and 41% of fathers complained they are multitasking “most of the time”.

68% of mothers and 69% of fathers said they have “too little time” with their spouse.

53% of mothers and 37% of fathers reported “always feeling rushed”.

52% of mothers and 58% of fathers expressed having “too little time” for their youngest child.

If you are in one, more than one or all of these categories or simply feel as if you cannot find a healthy balance in your life, please come to this small group. This purpose of this group will be to (1) discuss the challenges in finding balance in life, (2) share ways that each of us attempt to find such balance and (3) support one another in this journey. As a backdrop to these discussions, we will be reading a book titled “Practicing Balance: How Congregation Can Support Harmony in Work and Life” by David Grey. David describes his balancing act as “one family, two parents, three jobs and four kids”. He is the pastor of Bradley Hills Presbyterian Church and director of the Workforce and Family Program at the New American Foundation. 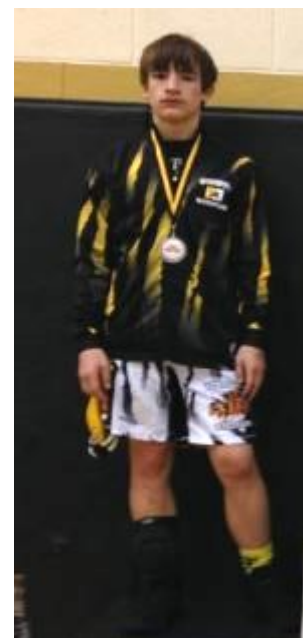

DEACON NOMINATION AND ELECTION

Nomination Sunday: January 25, 2015

Election Sunday: February 8, 2015

This January and February, we will nominate and elect four persons to serve three-year terms as deacons. What is a deacon? A deacon is a lay minister. Deacons are ordained for life and elected to three-year terms of active service. Deacons' most visible duties include assisting the clergy in administering the Lord's Supper, visiting the sick, and reaching out in mission. The Deacons meet on a monthly basis and prayerfully consider all the business and ministries of the church.

According to our church constitution, persons elected to serve as deacons should be dedicated Christians who possess spiritual maturity. Scriptures in Phil 1:1; 1 Timothy 3:8-13; Romans 16:1 and Matt 28:19-20 give guidance to those considering deacon service. To be eligible to serve as a deacon at Midway Baptist, a person must have been a member for at least two consecutive years or been a member for at least one year and has previously served as a deacon in another church.

What makes a good deacon? First of all, someone you can look up to. "Full of the Holy Spirit," "faith," and "wisdom," God says (Acts 6:3, 5). Second, choose someone who will show up. A good deacon attends worship weekly, as well as many other church events—midweek services, special events, meetings, and so on. If someone is too busy to be here when the rest of us are here, they are too busy to be a deacon. Third, a good deacon is someone who can work well with the clergy, congregation, and the other deacons. No deacon and no clergyman is perfect. We are all in a process of growth, being transformed into the image of Christ. But some followers of Jesus make better deacons than others. Please begin praying now about this important choice.

On January 25th in both Sunday morning services, you will be asked to nominate up to four (4) eligible persons to serve as deacons of Midway Baptist Church for the three-year term beginning March 2015. (Please do NOT nominate the following: *Iraline Craig, Chad Royalty, Ron Wyatt, David Campbell, Letha Drury, David McCoun, Paul Simmons, Allen Dobson, Dave Forman, Kaye Hall and Darin Hensley*. From the list of nominees who are eligible and willing to serve, a ballot will be presented to the church on Sunday, February 8th in both Sunday morning services. The four persons receiving the most votes will be elected to serve.

The following deacons have one year left to serve:

David Campbell, Letha Drury, David McCoun and Paul Simmons.

The following deacons have two years left to serve:

Please be in prayer about this important decision, and talk with those you are considering nominating to see if they would be willing to serve if elected.

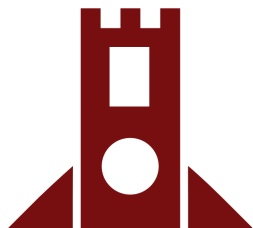
