

Cave Quest VBS will be Sunday, June 26, through Wednesday, June 29, from 6-8:30 p.m. There are many ways that you can help, from leading a station to guiding a crew of kids through the night to providing support to station leaders. Please see below for some brief job descriptions and consider volunteering to be a part of this important annual event for our children. 1) Elementary Crew Leader (5 needed). Crew Leaders don't have to prepare anything; they just come each day, guide their Crew members through activities, help facilitate discussions, and generally join in the VBS fun.

2) Preschool Crew Leader (2 needed). Like Elementary Crew Leaders, Preschool Crew Leaders don't need to prepare anything in advance. They'll help their preschool Crews follow directions given by the Station Leaders.

3) Elementary Station Leader. Station Leaders prepare and teach the material in the station leader manuals. Station leader manuals are scripted and easy to follow. Supplies will be made available for you; you'll just need to make sure they are organized and prepared for each evening.

4) Preschool Station Leader. Preschool Station Leaders prepare and teach the material in the preschool station leader guides in the Tad's Preschool Pool area. Station leader manuals are scripted and easy to follow. Supplies will be made available for you; you'll just need to make sure they are organized and prepared for each evening.

5) Sign-In Personnel. Sign-in personnel are people who are friendly and outgoing. Sign-in personnel assist the registrar, help kids find their crews as they arrive, and help to keep record of who is in attendance each night.

6) Support Volunteers. Support volunteers don't have to prepare anything. They are responsible for assisting Station Leaders with prep and activities.
