We are at it again, working on the 2016 budget with the plan to present the initial draft at the next business meeting on Oct. 18<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. Please plan to join us as your input is vital to this process! A vote on the budget will be conducted at the Dec. business meeting and copies of the draft will be available on the table in the foyer beforehand. We look forward to your input and feedback.

Speaking of budgets, what a year! As Kaye noted on Anticipation Sunday, we continue to grow in generosity and step up our giving. Highlights have included the purchase of a new playground, special gifts to the Backpack Ministry, the Food Pantry and the Haiti mission trip, as well as more than \$5300 given towards paying down our loan, all thanks to your generous gifts! We've also accomplished the not so fun projects such as replacing the basement furnace (any day now), kitchen repairs and grounds upkeep. It's amazing to think that this time last year we were more than \$19,000 behind budget. It has indeed been a blessed year.

Here's a brief summary of giving to date along with a couple upcoming activities.



#### CODY DAVIDSON TENDERS RESIGNATION AS ASSOCIATE PASTOR

The Personnel Committee has regretfully accepted the resignation of Dr. Cody Davidson as our Associate Pastor, effective on November 1, 2015.

Cody was hired in 2004, shortly following his graduation from seminary in North Carolina. Cody and Carrie moved into what is currently our Youth House and began work as Youth Minister and Associate Pastor with a ¾ time assignment. Cody also worked part time at Georgetown College in the Education Department with Dave Forman. In 2005 Cody accepted a full time position at Bluegrass Community and Technical College and transitioned to a part time position as Education Minister at MBC.

Over his tenure here at Midway, Cody and Carrie's work responsibilities has grown, along with their family. Daughter Evie was born in 2009 and Noelle followed in 2012. During this time Cody accepted a position at KCTCS, started an adjunct teaching job with Maysville Community College and completed his Doctor of Philosophy degree at U of L. Dr. Davidson is published in many academic journals, serves on the editorial board of two journals and is the co-author of book chapters relating to higher education. In 2014 he accepted a new position as Director of Administrative Leadership for Kentucky Adult Education and also is teaching organizational leadership and learning courses for the University of Louisville. Carrie is a Health and Wellness Specialist at UK and is also working toward her PhD. For the past 10 years Cody has been an active runner and has completed numerous races and marathons, including a 50 mile race in 2014.

During Cody's time at Midway he has served along with three senior pastors, two interim pastors and a changing cast of characters on the Ministry Council and Personnel Committee, always accepted ever-changing roles and kept a smile on his face! Under his leadership at Midway, our church has expanded our opportunities for education, including a vibrant Sunday School, numerous mid-week small groups and offerings for community enrichment through GED and ESL learning. Cody has taught Adult Bible Study, Young Adult Sunday School, many small group classes and has chaired the Ministry Council, which organizes the church calendar of events. Cody has helped organize recreational sports teams as well as summertime fellowship experiences, such as Master Chef, the annual Church Picnic and Corn Hole Tournament that are now a part of our church culture. However, Cody may best be remembered for the annual VBS skits along with Children's Minister, Andrea Ball where he always seemed to slightly misunderstand the theme of the bible school!

Please join us on Sunday, November 1<sup>st</sup>, as we honor Cody on his last day with us as Associate Pastor. We will host a big breakfast in his honor and also acknowledge him in both worship services. The Davidsons will take some time to prepare for the birth of their son, sometime early in 2016. As Cody himself has said, "Midway is our family's church and we are part of this community. We look forward to continuing our relationship with MBC as members. The past 11 ½ years has been a wonderful experience in ministry."

## HAITI JEWELRY & CHRISTMAS ORNAMENTS

From your Haiti Mission Team:

Our Haiti Mission team continues to sell jewelry from The Apparent Project. The Apparent Project is an organization that employs local Haitian men and women and provides them the opportunity to work and earn money, that in turn, allows them to support their children. These unique earrings and bracelets are made from recycled cereal boxes, while the necklaces are made from recycled oil drums and local Haitian red clay. And coming soon....Christmas Ornaments! These beautiful ornaments are made from recycled oil drums and are hand-stamped by the Haitian artists. Each ornament is topped with a cereal-box bead and ribbon. The ornaments are expected to arrive late September/early October. The prices has yet to be decided, but we will let you know once our shipment arrives.

Earrings: \$10 Bracelets: \$12

Necklaces: \$15 (reduced from \$18)

Ornaments: \$10

Additionally, we are still collecting cereal boxes to send to The Apparent Project. We have collected 222 boxes so far! Did you know that just 1 box can yield up to \$40 profit when made into beads for the earrings and bracelets. The Apparent Project goes through hundreds of boxes each day, so please bring in your cereal boxes and drop them into the green basket in room 100.
